

Children can register for 1 to 7 weeks

HOURS

Monday - Friday, 10:00 am - 3:00 pm

Morning program available from 8:30 -10am

Afternoon program available from 3 - 4:30 pm

AGES

The core program is for kids ages 5-12
(Child must have completed kindergarten)

We offer a teen program for young adults with developmental disabilities or autism, ages 13-21.

MEALS

Children bring lunch from home.

STAFF

Our Staff is a mix of teachers, coaches, high school and college students. A full-time nurse is also on staff to meet the needs of all campers. All staff participate in a two-day orientation class prior to the start of camp.

GROUPS

Children are grouped by age, with a staff to camper ratio of 2:12 minimum.

FEES

Free for children enrolled in the HCBS Waiver and approved for Respite Services.

\$200 per week for all other children. Morning Program and Afternoon Programs are available for an additional \$30/week each.

Families enrolling more than one child will receive 10% off for each additional child.

*A \$100 registration fee is required for each camper NOT enrolled in the HCBS Waiver.
